

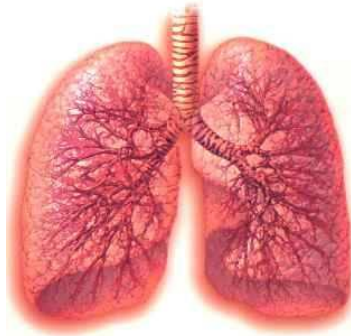


RED e-news

CFWA 2010 Award Winners

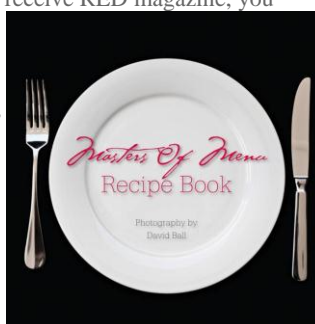
