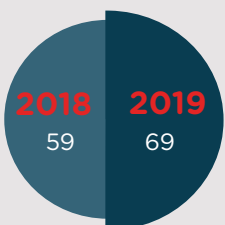
Queensland Health provide to our members holding health care cards. For non-card holders, Cystic Fibrosis Queensland provides this equipment



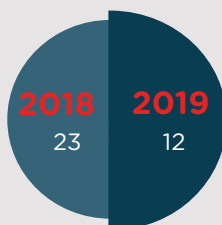
